This training will cover topics such as: proper location of residential sprinklers, piping methods, water supplies, hangers and hydraulic calculations. The class will provide a “hands on” plan review and exercises in each subject area.

The half-day class is intended for individuals with little or no experience with residential fire sprinkler systems and will provide an overview of the performance objectives, design requirements, spacing considerations, piping options and water supplies for these systems.

The two-day class is intended to follow up and reinforce the first class. This course will provide an in depth discussion of residential systems filled with numerous examples, hands on exercises and methods of reviewing hydraulic calculations. The day will finish with an actual plan review of a residential system and calculations. Many useful checklists, charts, and data sheets will be provided.

Earn .4 CEUs for the half-day course, and 1.4 CEUs for the two-day course.

Who should attend? Fire Prevention Officers, Building Officials, students, design professionals, or anyone involved with the plan review, acceptance and inspection of residential fire sprinkler installations are welcome.

What should you bring? All reference materials will be provided, however, you must come prepared with a calculator and an architectural scale.
